Children of UK Service Personnel and Crown Servants

In cases of children of UK service personnel (UK armed forces) with a confirmed posting or children of Crown servants returning from overset area forces) with a place in advance of the family arriving in the area (as long as one is available), provided publication is accompanied by an official letter confirming the relocation date is an exception to the rule that the child must be living the address at the time of application.

Random allocation will not be applied to multiple birth siblings (twins and triplets etc.) from the same family tied for the final place. We will admit them all and exceed our PAN.

Admission of Children Below Compulsory School Age and Deferred Entry to Reception Year

Children are entitled to a futlime place inschool in the Septemberfollowing their fourth birthday. Children do not, however, reach compulsory school age until one of three prescribed days following their fifth birthday (or on their fifth birthday, if it falls on a prescribed day). These prescribed days are 31 December, 31 March and 31 August.

Parents where child is offered place in Reception Year have a right to decide that they will defer the date that their child will start school until later in the school year, without losing the achieved place. Admission cannot be deferred beyond the date that the child would reach compulsory school age and not beyond the beginning of the final term of the school year for which the offer was madeParents who defer the date that their child will start school must agree the decision in writing with the chool.

Part-Time Attendance in Reception Year

Parents have a right to decide that their child will attend School-tipante until they reach compulsory school age.

For example, a child born on 15 February will not reach compulsory school age until 31 March following their fifth birthdaybut is entitled to a full
